In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the 2006 Lowcountry Traditional Karate Championships athletics/sports program, and related events and activities, the undersigned:

1. Agrees that prior to participating, they know and understand the Rules of Competition, and that they (if under 18 years of age a Parent or Guardian) will inspect the facilities and equipment to be used, and if the participant and/or Parent or Guardian, believes anything is, or may be, unsafe, they will immediately advise their coach or supervisor and 2006 Lowcountry Traditional Karate Championships personnel of such condition(s) and refuse to participate unless and until such condition is remedied.
2. Acknowledge and fully understand that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses which might result not only from their own actions, inaction's or negligence but the actions, inaction's or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used. ## Directions to home tournament

### **From Columbia**

Take I-26 East toward Charleston. At Exit 169, which is I-95, go toward Savannah. Leave I-95 at Exit 57. Turn left at the end of the exit. Go to the first traffic light and turn left. There will be a Reid's Store on your left at the traffic light. You will be on Robertson Blvd. Go approximately three quarters of a mile to the first traffic light, which is North Jefferies Blvd. Turn left on to North Jefferies. This is also Hwy. 15. Go approximately one mile to the first traffic light, which is Mighty Cougar Drive, and turn right. There will be a mobile home dealer at this intersection. Follow road pass the high school to the stop sign. Turn right, go about 50 feet and turn right onto Recreation Lane . Follow the road to the Recreation Center.

### **From Summerville:**

Take Hwy. 17A to Walterboro. At the intersection (stoplight) with Hwy. 64, which is Robertson Blvd., turn right. There will be an Amoco Station at the intersection. Go approximately one-half miles to the stoplight (North Jefferies Blvd.). When you get to North Jefferies Blvd.(US Hwy. 15), turn right. There will be a Texaco Station at North Jefferies Blvd. Go approximately one mile to stoplight (Mighty Cougar Drive) and turn right. Follow road pass the high school to the stop sign. Turn right, go about 50 feet and turn right onto Recreation Lane . Follow the road to the Recreation Center.

### **From Savannah and Beaufort (I-95 South)**

Take I-95 North to Exit 57. From EXIT #57(Walterboro) follow **Columbia's** direction.

### **From Florence SC, NY, VA, NC, (I-95 North)**

Take I-95 South to Exit 57. From EXIT #57(Walterboro) follow **Columbia's** direction.

### **From Charleston:**

Take Hwy. 17 South toward Savannah and Beaufort. In **Jacksonboro**, bear right on Hwy. 64 toward Walterboro. Follow US 64 to Walterboro at the first stoplight. When you get in Walterboro, turn right on to Hwy 64, which is Robertson Blvd. Go straight through the first stoplight past the Amoco to the second traffic light, which is North Jefferies Blvd. (US Hwy. 15). Turn right on to North Jefferies. This is also Hwy. 15. Go approximately one mile to the first traffic light, which is Mighty Cougar Drive, and turn right. Follow road pass the high school to the stop sign. Turn right, go about 50 feet and turn right onto Recreation Lane . Follow the road to the Recreation Center.
